

An *intensifier* is an adverb or adverbial phrase that strengthen the meaning of other expressions and show





Extreme adjectives are words that give a special emphasis to one or some characteristics of the subject.

- The book was hilarious... I couldn't stop laughing!
- That movie was **fantastic**! I recommend it to everyone.
- All the people were **terrified** watching that horror movie at the cinema.
- The director was delighted to receive the Nobel Prize.
